A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE POLICY OF IIEE BRANDING LOGO AND FOR RELATED PURPOSES

WHEREAS, IIEE recognizes the importance of a cohesive and recognizable brand identity to establish a strong presence in the market and for related purposes pursuant to the trademark registration with the Intellectual Property Office;

WHEREAS, the Board acknowledges that the IIEE Branding Logo will be used in various marketing and communication materials, including but not limited to websites, social media platforms, print materials, and promotional items;

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes the need for a clear policy governing the use, application, and protection of the IIEE Branding Logo to ensure consistency, integrity, and proper representation of IIEE's brand;

WHEREAS, that the policy endorsed by the Ad Hoc Committee on Branding to develop and implement a comprehensive policy governing the use, application, and protection of the IIEE Branding Logo, which shall include guidelines on logo usage, color specifications, font usage, and any other relevant branding elements;

WHEREAS, the policy shall address the appropriate usage of the IIEE Branding Logo by employees, contractors, vendors, and other third parties associated with IIEE, ensuring compliance with copyright laws, trademark regulations, and other applicable legal requirement

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, taking note of all the foregoing and on motion of Bicol Regional Governor, Edgardo U. Aragon, duly seconded by the Eastern Central Visayas Regional Governor, Brian A. Pasilan, the Board;

RESOLVED as it hereby resolves, approving the proposed policy on IIEE Branding Logo as endorsed to the Board;

The IIEE Brand - IIEE Logo

The IIEE logo parts are as described in the image below.



At the center is "I" square and "E" square or "IIEE" with the year it was established in 1975.

Words on diamond is "Institute of Integrated Electrical Engineers" (IIEE as acronym)

Above logo should be the first choice of logo as it is the primary variant of the IIEE logo. It should always be used on a white or light background.

Variants can be used as black and white as show below or as a monochrome variant (single color or nearest to the shades of the background color e.g., on coat, etc.)





Here are proper use and prohibition:

- Do not place the IIEE logo on busy backgrounds e.g., logo should not be blocked; logo should be easily seen and identified
- Do not place any mark, wording, design, etc. inside the logo
- Leave ample space around the logo (mark, wording, design, etc. must be outside the "imaginary" diamond, square or circle of the logo perimeter)
- Do not use different color combinations in print. However, for merchandise (embroidery, pins, etc.), the nearest color shades are acceptable.
- ☐ Do not use different I² and E² design for the IIEE logo
- No limitation on size as long as readable.
- All chapters shall only use one IIEE logo, as above, on official documents, legal tenders and the like e.g. certificates, agreements, etc.

IMPORTANT: IIEE logo is property of IIEE and the logo cannot be used by anyone else without a signed trademark agreement. If you see someone is using the IIEE logo and you are unsure if they are allowed or have no trademark nor royalty agreement, report it to IIEE. IIEE CBL states in article XXI Sec. 1.0 Inscription. The corporate seal shall inscribe thereon the name of the Institute and the official trademark as registered in the Philippine Intellectual Property Office. **Unauthorized use** of the corporate seal and trademark shall be subject to sanction or legal action by the Institute. IIEE logo is first registered with Trademark No. 4/2017/00000251 (see attached last page).

NOTE: Different I² and E² design, color or partly resemblance of the logo may be allowed as unique insignia of the chapter, committee or the like particularly for **promotion purposes**. Exact replica of the IIEE logo cannot be altered as insignia. However, if the whole IIEE logo will be part of insignia or "theme year" emblem, then the IIEE logo must comply with above rules.
